The Landscape Labourer will assist with the construction and maintenance of our Powwow Grounds in preparation for the annual Powwow. The Landscape Labourer will participate in daily huddles with the Public Works Team to coordinate their daily activities and duties.

- Care and usage of small equipment including riding lawnmowers and weed trimmers
- Assists and performs minor repairs, painting and maintenance as required
